A New **Free School** (Alternative Provision) Opening September 2012

The Department for Education has given us the go ahead to begin to build partnerships towards opening this exciting new FREE SCHOOL in Everton, one of the first of the Alternative Provision schools to be approved by the DFE.

Since 2005, Liverpool Lighthouse has run a highly successful Alternative Education Project engaging with between 60 and 80 mainly KS4 and Post 16 Students each year. The AEP will be transitioned to 'Harmonize Academy' by September 2012, and will build on this success with:

- ◆ exciting new ideas
- ◆ expanded curriculum
- ◆ a pastoral system that is proven
- ◆ brand new facilities
- ◆ upgraded performance

Harmonize Academy will provide places for 100 students, majority in KS4. A small number of places will be available for KS3 students with close working arrangement with placement schools.
